

JURJEN PRONK WORKS OF ART



A large bronze tripod incense burner

Qianlong (1735 - 1796)
39.5 cm tall including the wooden stand.

Of inverted bell shape, the body cast in relief with lotus flowers and foliate motifs, flanked by elephant-head handles with raised trunks and supported on three elephant-head feet. The domed cover is similarly decorated and surmounted by a reclining elephant finial carrying a bowl of gemstones. The heavy casting is finished with a rich chocolate-brown patina and inlaid coloured glass.
