Floorlamp 'Angel Wing', model A805

Materials: Painted steel, brass, leather
Designed: 1954
Executed: Valaistustyö, Finland late 1950's
Stamped: Valaistustyö and A805

One of Alvar Aalto's most appreciated lamp designs, the 'Angel Wing', was designed in 1954 for the National Pension Institute in Helsinki. The lightshade is constructed with white painted metal strips in an asymmetrical shape, resembling a wing (hence the name). The shade is mounted on a brass stem, with a single light. The bottom part and the base of the stem are wrapped in subtle black leather, stitched together in a single seam. The lamp is fully stamped with both the model number and maker on the upper brass ring on top of the leather wrapping. Indicating this is a very sought-after early production example in beautiful all original condition.
