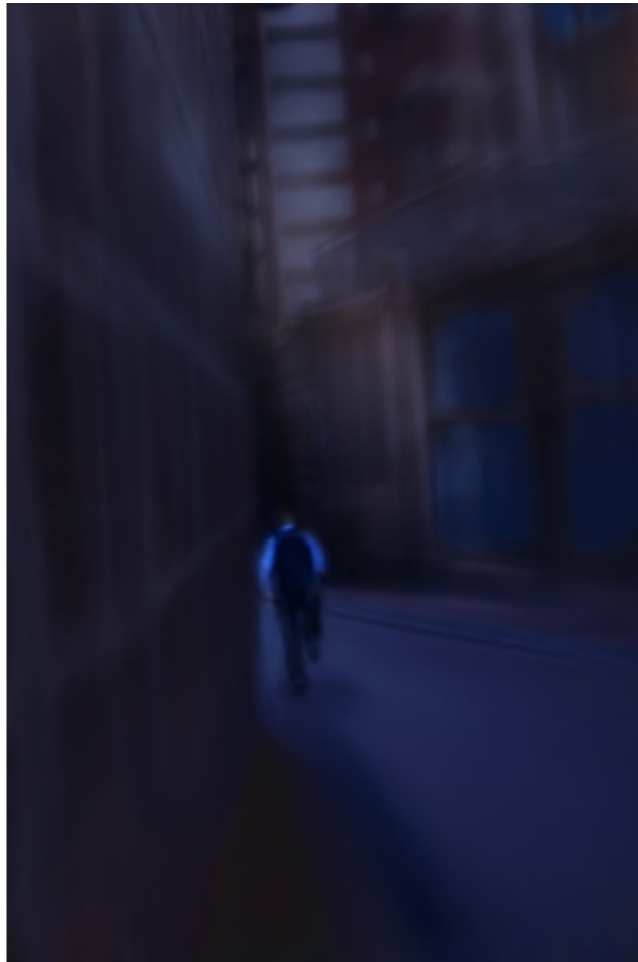

The photographs suggest a narrative but deliberately withhold definitive answers. J.D. creates evocative works that invite viewers to form their own interpretations of the story. His photography explores themes such as solitude, alienation, disconnection, fear, consumerism, and the overstimulation caused by media in contemporary society.

Currently, J.D. is working on a photography project that serves as a visual exploration of the human struggle in an increasingly complex, fast-paced, and constrained world.

J.D. was born in The Hague in 1966 and currently resides in Amsterdam. After graduating from the Netherlands Film Academy with a specialization in film directing and fiction, he began his career as a director, focusing primarily on commercial and documentary projects. In recent years, photography has become another significant focus in his life.
